The application for a double major consists of the following:

- 1 ■ statement of purpose
- 2 ■ signature of your adviser
- 3 ■ completed double major course plan
- 4 ■ signature of both department chairs

In applying for a double major you are stating your intention to complete two unique majors as described in the Pomona College Catalog. Double majors are required to take all required courses for the two majors **including separate and unique senior exercises for each.**

Bear in mind, when deciding whether to complete a double major, that the large number of required courses will restrict your opportunities to explore the nuances of a single major. When planning your course schedule on the following page, think about how your two major choices can enable you to both achieve breadth in your liberal arts education as well as enable you to get the most from the disciplined thought and approaches your two majors promise. Avoid course overlaps between the two majors, choosing major electives that are not common to both majors. There should not be more than a 3-4 courses which mutually apply to both majors.

Instructions

Supply a short paragraph below explaining why you wish to be allowed to graduate with two majors. On the attached sheet list all the courses you will take to complete the two majors. This form must be signed by both department chairs and your adviser. Your adviser must be a member of one of your major departments.
